2020 APPEAL IMPACT

Thank you! The unprecedented times of 2020 delayed some kingdom-building investments, but your generosity still empowered your fellow members to develop and implement cutting-edge ministries to win souls for God's kingdom.

REMOTE BIBLE WORKERS

Three dedicated Bible Workers have been assigned to the inland churches of Bourke, Coonamble and Armidale. BCA 2020 funds are still available to support more workers so if you are interested, please ask Matt Parra about the attributes of a front-line Bible Worker and the exciting adventures they experience.



FAITH FM BREAKFAST SHOW

The Faith FM Breakfast Show continued uninterrupted throughout a year when radio ministries were as important as ever. With many communities in lock down, Lyle Southwell and his team were still able to 'walk through walls' and reach the hearts of thousands with God's present truth.



ADVENTIST COMMUNITY SERVICES

The Wyee Community Hub is now under construction and will soon be reaching people for God's Kingdom. The 'paper-title-people', a whole community living right next to the Hub with no water or sewers, paved roads, guttering or street lighting, will be the first very grateful beneficiaries. UNIVERSITY MINISTRIES

A University Ministries Summit inspired and trained students to lead their peers to an eternity with Jesus. University evangelism grants have been distributed, new resources are being prepared for all seven NNSW campuses and a Bible Worker with a heart for soul winning is being placed at SCU in Lismore.

CENTRES OF INFLUENCE

2020 Appeal funds were invested in a Bible Worker for the Newstart Juice Bar ministry and marketing for Manna Haven Café in Byron Bay, with great success. Both centres reported an increase in community members consistently attending church. The Food Farmacy in Cardiff commenced construction in April 2021.



SPONSORSHIPS OF YOUNG PEOPLE

Sadly, COVID regulations cancelled 75% of the planned camps, however five young people from country areas were sponsored to attend a camp and many more will be sponsored when the camps recommence in 2021.

CHILDREN'S EVANGELISM

The planned regional KidsReach Rallies were 'COVIDised', but we were still able to fund two evangelistically focused episodes of King's Kids online, allowing us to share the good news with an even larger audience of children across the conference and beyond.

ONLINE EVANGELISM

FILM PRODUCTION

- **Kingdom Come** (our Daniel 2 documentary) is now on 12 TV channels and in 8 languages online with 40,000+ views every day! (8m+ views total). Funds will help to produce two more episodes, *Dominion* (Daniel 7-9) and *Downfall* (Revelation 13 & Matthew 24). kingdomcome.com.au/watch/

CHURCH MULTIPLICATION

- **Church Planting Training:** A short-term intensive church planting training based on-location in successful church plants in NNSW.
- **Lismore Mission Hub:** Support Lismore Church who will be launching church planting projects in Southern Cross University (Lismore) and Evans Head.
- **Central Coast Samoan Church Plant:** Support the Central Coast Seventh-day Adventist Church plant team who are reaching out to the 400 Samoans living on the Central Coast.
- **Tweed Shire:** Support churches in the rapidly growing Tweed Shire as they focus on reaching their communities by becoming mission hubs and planting new congregations.
- **Food Farmacy Mission Hub:** Support the team as they pilot a discipleship and missional training hub out of the Food Farmacy Centre of Influence, with the goal of planting new churches.

LOCAL MISSIONS TRAINING

- Support the LMT program running at Murwillumbah Church and those who graduate ready to serve.
